




HOW TO USE THE ROLLOVER TRANSITIONER

1. **Style** your graphic or text box.

2. **Switch** to the “Rollover” state for a graphic or text box and change the style. This will be the appearance that we are transitioning to.

Transitionable properties include:

Fill Color, Object Opacity, Border Radius, Border Color, Corner Radius, Image fill position, Padding, Text Size, Text Tracking (Character Spacing), Text Leading (Line Spacing), Text Indent, Text Color,



3. **Drag and drop** the Rollover Transitioner from the Library Panel to your page. It does not matter where you place it on the page. I designed it that way =)

4. **Customize** the settings. Increase Transition Duration for a slower effect, decrease it for a faster effect. Change the Easing Style to adjust the animation to your liking.

Note:

To apply it to several pages at once, just put it on your Master Page(s).



Rollover Transitioner Options

1. Design your elements with Normal and Rollover states.
2. Choose a duration and style for your transitions.

Transition Duration (Seconds): 0.5

Easing Style: Ease In and Out
